

Forte's policy on open access

All peer-reviewed conference and journal publications resulting from research wholly or partially funded by Forte should be published with open access.

- Researchers who receive funding from Forte must publish their articles with open access with a maximum delay of six months. This can either be by archiving a previously published article in an open searchable archive with a maximum embargo period of six months, or immediately available in a journal that allows open access (pure open access or hybrid). Information for researchers must be provided in conjunction with the call for proposals and applies to all forms of research grants awarded.
- All approved project grants in the annual open call for proposals are given a general grant of 30 000 SEK for open access publishing.
- For journals that apply for publishing grants from Forte, only those that have a maximum six-month embargo for archiving a published article in an open searchable archive and/or are transitioning to pure open access publication, will be considered for publication grants.
