## Which grants can I apply for if I already have an ongoing grant from Forte?

As a general rule, the limitations above apply to applicants who already have an ongoing grant from Forte. However, specific restrictions may apply in individual calls. You are therefore advised to carefully read the webpage for the call you intend to apply for. A grant is considered ongoing during the project period (referred to as the “grant period” in the terms and conditions of the awarded grant). After the grant period, there is a disposition period (the length of which is specified in the grant conditions but is usually twelve months). The disposition period is not considered an ongoing grant. You may apply for funding as the main applicant even if you participate as a participating researcher in one or more ongoing projects.
