

Conference grant II 2023

Information about the call

Focus area

The grant relates to financial support for arranging conferences hosted by a Swedish institution of higher education or scientific/scholarly organisation. The financial support is primarily intended for national conferences held in Sweden, that however are encouraged to include international elements. International elements mainly mean invited speakers from other countries. The intention is to facilitate contacts and exchange of experience between Swedish and foreign researchers, and to contribute to the dissemination of Swedish research internationally.

The conference grant may include costs (transportation, meals and accommodations) for invited speakers, grants to facilitate the participation of students, and work for planning the conference. A conference dinner of a simpler kind (excluding alcoholic beverages) can be included in the amount applied for from Forte. Side events such as sightseeing, museum visits and excursions are not costs that may be included in the amount applied for from Forte.

The conference must be held within 15 months from the start of the project, be arranged in Sweden and with at least 30 participants.

Grant type

Only one type of grant is available within this call: Conference grant.

Grant limit: The amount granted may amount to a maximum of SEK 300,000.

Please note that all grant limits are including indirect costs (OH). Applications exceeding the specified grant limit (300 000 SEK) will be rejected.

Time plan: State one year in the application. All grants have a three-month period for utilisation after the project period, which means that there is a total of 15 months to arrange the conference.

The application process

NB! Forte changes back to conference grants being applied for by an individual researcher, not through the organisation (administrating organisation).

All applications are submitted through the Prisma application and review system. Before writing your application, make sure the following conditions are met:



- You have created a personal account in Prisma.
- Your administrating organisation has an organisational account in Prisma and has been approved as an administrating organisation at Forte. <u>Read more about Forte's criteria for administrating organisations »</u>

- Communication and dissemination of research and enabling a dialogue between researchers and actors in areas relevant to Forte.
- Effort to reach out to and facilitate participation for target groups that are important to Forte.
- Reasonableness of budgeted costs
